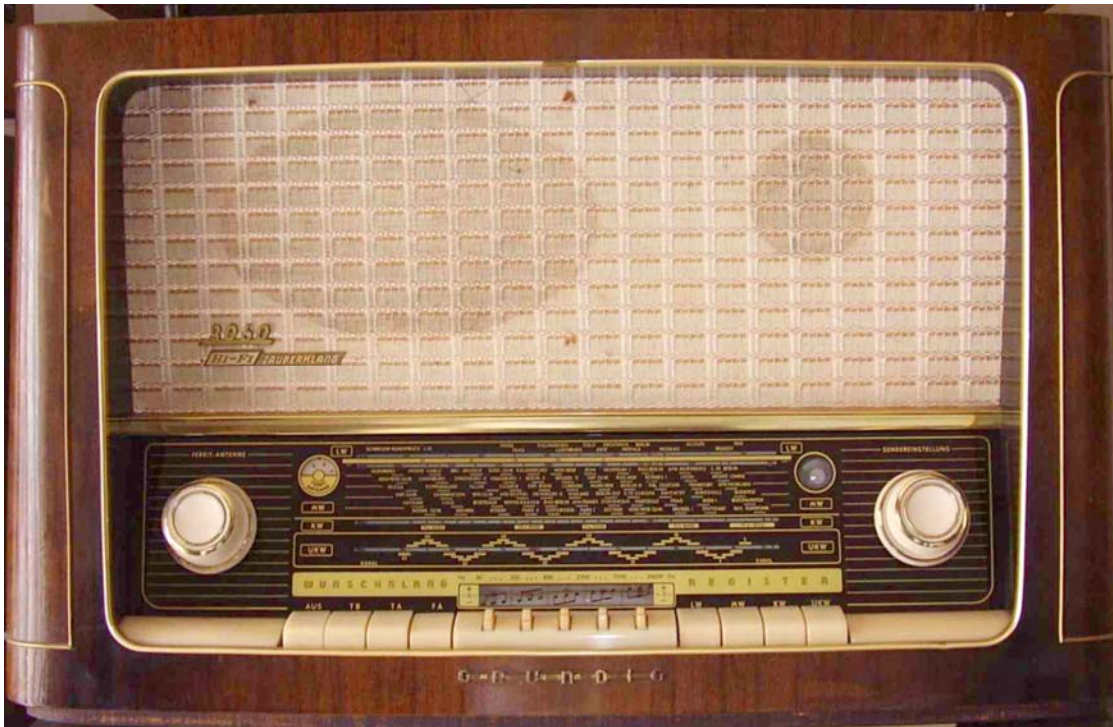


Radio Grundig 3060a Hi-Fi Zauberklang, 1956



This is another high end radio from the late fifties, made precious by the rounded corners of the mahogany cabinet and by the wide use of golden details matched with the ivory of keys and knobs. The label says 'Hi-Fi Zauberklang', which stays for Hi-Fi Magic Sound: extreme care was given to the design of audio stages, which included a five bands graphic equalizer, bandwidth from 30Hz to 20KHz, and four speakers. Three AM and one FM bands, with two dials driven by a single tuning knob. Built-in antennas: AM ferrite rod can be oriented from the panel. Connectors for record player, for tape recorder, for external speaker system, for echo chamber and for remote control. Seven tubes plus selenium bridge rectifier: ECC85, ECH81, EBF89, EAA91, ECC81, EL84, EM34/35, B250C100.

Key features:

- **Five band graphic equalizer**
- **Four speakers**
- **Connectors for echo chamber and for remote control**
