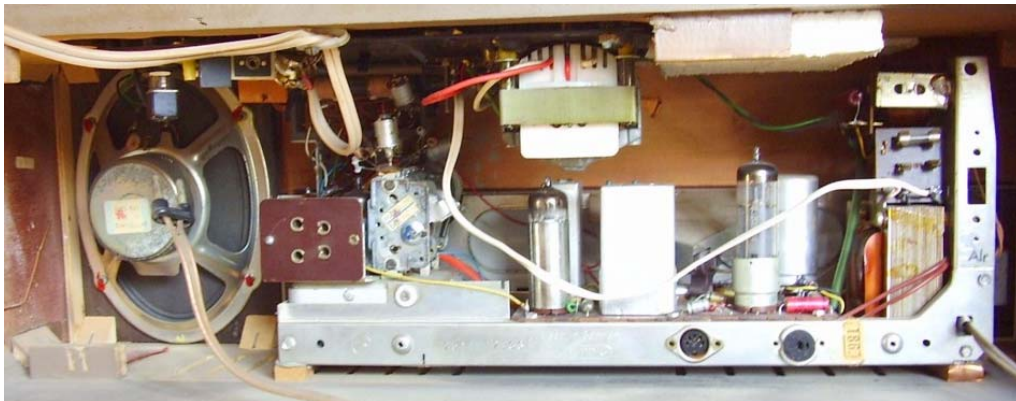


Grundig 2000 Ph, 1965



This radio must be included in the list of top models because of its superb engineering. Designers resorted to all their masterhip, to get the same performance of average sets in a radio using only three tubes. Indeed this is one of the very few superheterodyne sets where a single tube, ECC85, performs both AM and FM frequency conversion. The IF amplifier, EAF801, also acts as AM detector, while two AA119 germanium diodes are used in the FM discriminator. A ECL86 operates as audio pre and power amplifier. The radio also uses a selenium bridge rectifier in the power supply circuit.

The 2000 Ph was equipped with a Perpetuum Ebner PE31 record player.

Key features:
