

Radio Saba Meersburg W4, 1954



This radio, built in 1954, appears in its full elegance, with its rounded shape and the perfect matching of warm colours, mahogany, gold and ivory. The four bands, three AM and one FM, have two tuning dials driven by the two coaxial knobs on the right. Treble and bass controls. Built-in antennas, with the AM ferrite rod which can be oriented from the panel, by the inner knob on the left. Band switching keys light when selected. The radio has two coaxial speakers, one large elliptical woofer and a smaller electrostatic tweeter. Eight tubes, plus the selenium bridge rectifier: EF80, EC92, ECH81, EF42, EAF41, EABC80, EL84, EM71, B250C90.

Key features:

- **Extremely smooth tuning mechanism**
- **Lighted function selection keys**
- **Warm and loud sound**
