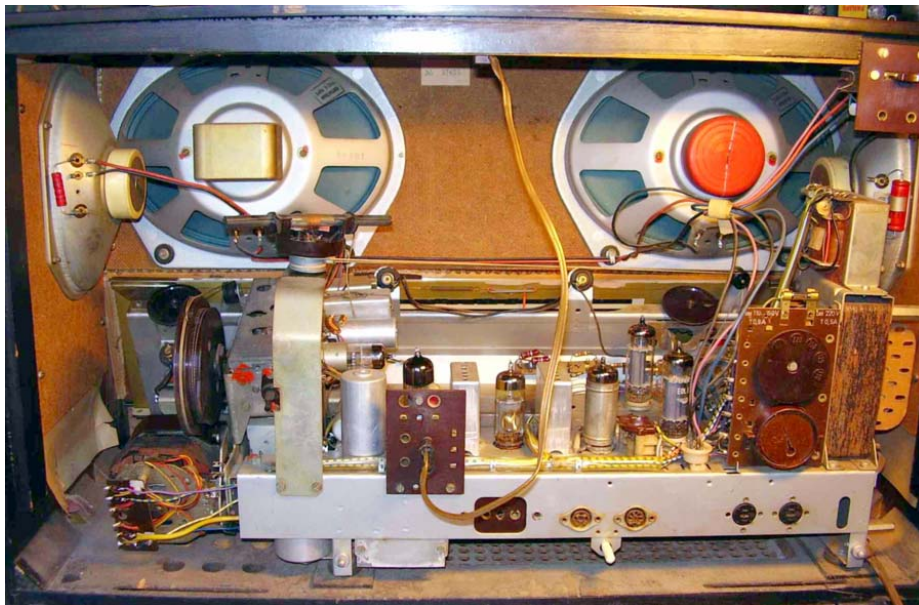


## Saba Meersburg Automatic 11 Stereo, 1961 – 1962



This huge top radio well represents the golden age of equipment using only electron tubes. Inside the modern looking wooden cabinet it collects the most refined solutions available in the early sixties. As usual, the radio covers three AM (LW, MW and KW) and one FM bands. All was designed and built to simply give the best, no compromise. Some of the remarkable features include: automatic motor driven tuning, stereo audio amplifier, switched into a push-pull like configuration when mono operation was selected, four speakers. The class of the equipment can be well understand considering the impressive figure of 13 lamps and indicator lights inside the front panel!

Nine tubes, EC92, ECH81, EF85, EABC80, ECL86, ECL80, EABC80, EM84, plus B250C125 and E25C2 selenium rectifiers.
