

## Sylvania Type 220 Tube Tester



Sylvania type 220 and the console version 219 were compact tube testers intended for use in radio service. In addition to a preliminary short/leakage indication, meter gave a composite reading of transconductance and emission. Even a gas test reading was available. Setting parameters were read from a self-contained roll chart. Early fifties.

The above sample was donated by Salvatore Balzamo, owner of one of the most known radio and television service centers in Naples. It is complete of original manual and test data updates to 1966. The unit was also modified, with the addition of a transformer, to operate from 220 V mains.
