

Revox A77-MKI - Reel-to-Reel Tape Recorder



A77 was the first solid state tape recorder sold by Willi Studer around 1967 under the brand Revox. The tape transport was only slightly updated with respect to the traditional Revox scheme. 10-inch reels, 2 speeds, three motors, three heads and solenoid actuated brakes and pinch roller. The electronic was completely revised and configurable, using small PCB plug-in modules.

The base model was offered with the choice of several options. The speed could be selectable 9.5/19 cm/s or 19/38 cm/s, 2 or 4 tracks. The output power amplifiers were offered as options and even a version with built in monitor speakers was available.
