

6701 - Low-Voltage Beam Switching Decade Counter



The 6701, also known as HB-101, is an early Beam Switching tube with large external magnet. Low voltage variant of original Haydu/Burroughs [6700](#), capable of operation at 20 V spade and anode voltage. 1 MHz counting speed.
