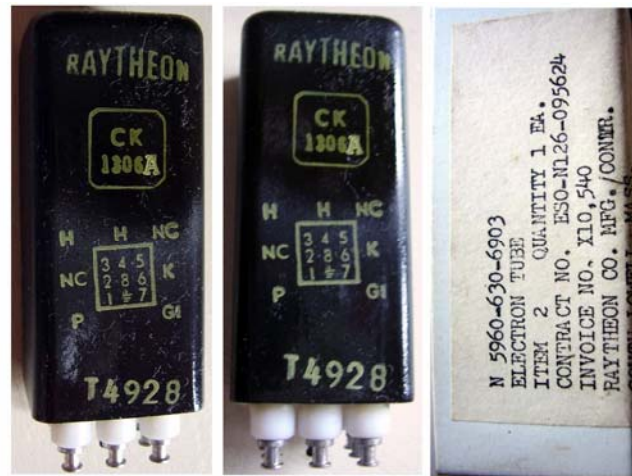


## CK1306A - Triode, Subminiature Shielded



No data available for this shielded vacuum triode. Probably very similar to the low-microphonic CK5744WA mounted into a magnetic shield.

I just remember to have seen something similar around 1966 in a junkyard, 'don Umberto', among parts coming from Selenia. I have faded memories of some boxes full of similar tubes made by CSF and of aluminum panels carrying two rows of these tubes and their wiring harness. I also opened a couple of metal envelopes which just contained the subminiature tube held by a clamp, flying leads covered by teflon tubing and connected to the base fed-throughs.

Believed to be part of the active guidance system of early Mark 44 torpedoes. These tubes could have been used in the low-level amplifiers of the magnetostrictive sensors of the searching head before updating to solid-state.
