

CK1307A - Triode, Subminiature Shielded



No data available for this shielded vacuum triode.

I just remember to have seen something similar around 1966 in a junkyard, 'don Umberto', among parts coming from Selenia. I have faded memories of these tubes and of some aluminum panels carrying two rows of them and their wiring harness. I also opened a couple of metal envelopes and I remember that each of them just contained a subminiature tube, the flying leads connected to the teflon insulated feed-through turrets.

Believed to be part of the active guidance system of Mark 44 torpedoes. These tubes could have been used in the low-level amplifiers of the magnetostrictive sensors of the searching head.
