

MT31 – Transmitting Triode



Transmitting triode by Officine Marconi, Genova, Italy.

Equivalent to Telefunken [RS31g](#), to Fivre 3C70 and to Zenith (Philips) W31.

1600 V max anode voltage, 75 W plate dissipation.

10 V at 4.8 A filament.

Two in the A 350-1 trailer mounted transmitter, used by Italian Army for liason with Air Forces, 1935. Probably the same were used in the airborne transmitter A 320. Power amplifier was driven by a single [RS 69](#) / [MT-69](#).
