

VT31 – Power Transmitting Tetrode, Great Britain



British transmitting tube.

Lots were also produced in U.S. by Machlett and maybe by other firms during WWII, under the 'Lend & Lease Act'. U.S. production has the code 'VT-31' etched on the bulb but, due to its different size and shape, cannot be confused with the U.S. military VT-31. The sample above was made by Machlett.

250 W plate power dissipation, 5 kV anode voltage. Flying wires.

8 V at 11.25 A filament.
