

1DP1 Series - 3/4-inch Miniature CRT



1DP1, registered to National Union in November 1953, was the smallest CRT then available. It was mirably engineered into a T6½ bulb with 9-pin base, no visible exhaust pip. Electrostatic focus and deflection.

It was followed in 1955 by different screen variants, 1DP4, 1DP7 and 1DP11.

Here two samples, one of which experimental with reddish phosphor.
