

## 6498 – Memotron Storage CRT



Storage CRT used in the Hughes MemoScope 104D, the first storage oscilloscope introduced in 1955. 14-pin base plus 6 side caps. Also known with its Hughes proprietary name, Memotron.

Double electron guns: the first one, typically biased at -2600V, generates the focused writing beam, while the second cathode supplies low energy flooding refresh electrons.

6.3 volts heaters.
