

AT50 – 50 W Early Transmitting Triode



50 watt transmitting tube made for the British Army by MOV, Edison-Swan, BTH and A.C.Cossor Ltd.

Three "foot" style connections on base, also known as S3 base. Anode from a top screw terminal. Electrode structure is very similar to the one below, described at page 308 of *Thermoionic Tubes in Radio Telegraphy and Telephony* by Scott-Taggart, 1921.

7.3 volts at 2.6 amperes filament.
