

NT99 – UHF Micropup Transmitting Triode



Micropup power triode capable of operating down to 50 cm. The sample in the photo also shows its military coding as Admiralty Pattern or A.P. W2514. Full emission selection was approved as **CV1256**, low emission units being approved as **CV199**. Also interchangeable with 8026, **REL 7**, **4C27** and **CV92**.

Widely used in AMES11 50 cm mobile ground radar, in Naval fire control systems and in airborne AI and ASV radar equipment. Useful in grounded plate oscillator circuits up to about 600 MHz. Forced air-cooling required, directed to the integral finned radiator.

Half indirect cathode, 6 V at 6.5 A heater.
